

PROCEEDINGS OF THE IQAC MEETING HELD ON 30/01/2021

The virtual meeting was presided by Dr. Niranjana Murthy B. Dr. S. Nataraju welcomed the members of the IQAC to the meeting. Dr. N. Vani Shree briefed about the agenda and placed the same before the members.

The deliberations and resolutions passed during the online meeting which was held on 30th January, 2021, are as follows:

AGENDA 1 – Reading and recording of the previous IQAC meeting

The information regarding the performance of the college during the academic year 2019-20 was highlighted and the same was applauded by the external members. Online activities of the college during the pandemic were also appreciated.

DECISION – It was approved.

AGENDA 2 – Resuming of Offline Classes

Dr. G. B. Aravinda enquired about the pedagogy followed by the faculty members for online classes during the first wave of Covid-19 and about the preparation for the same to which the principal and other members replied that the study materials were being provided, written assignments and research work were being assigned and also the seminar presentations were done online.

Prof. K. S. Suresh explained about the conduct of the end semester examinations which was held in December, 2020, that the college decided to conduct the offline examinations as per the guidelines of the BCI, UGC and the SOP of the State Government. Accordingly, preparations were made at the college for sanitization of the whole college premises. The students were given standard instructions to be followed before entering the college premises for writing their exams. The seating arrangements were done by the college keeping in view social distancing and other precautions. Accordingly, the end semester exams were held and the results were declared. Further, he added that every other activity and programs were held online for which the response of the students were satisfactory.

DECISION: It was approved.

AGENDA 3: Annual Report 2020-21

The achievements of students and faculty members, academic and other events and also the progress of the college during the academic year was placed before the Committee and after a detailed discussion; the members appreciated the overall performances especially in the Moot Court competitions and NCC activities. Dr. N. Vani Shree also briefed the other curricular, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities of the college.

AGENDA 4: Proposed Plan for 2021-22

As per an earmarked plan few of the proposals were implemented like, online training for teaching faculty, attending the Refreshers' Course by the faculty members as per the UGC requirements, student's internship online and the like.

The honorable external members advised on the improvements that can be made in some of the areas in academic and other activities for which the Principal assured that efforts will be made by each and everyone for the overall development of the college.

AGENDA 5: Any other matter with the permission of the Chair

Ms. Saloni gave her suggestions about the student exchange programs and internships for the growth of the student fraternity. She also gave assurance that she would extend the contacts and networking for our students. Dr. Sukanya gave a lot of inputs for the preparation for re-accreditation by the NAAC and the IQAC functioning by citing her college instances.
