

A REPORT ON INDUSTRIAL VISIT TO SLN COFFEE PVT. LTD.

Venue of the visit – No.47, K.I.A.D.B Industrial Area, Kudlur, Kushalnagar, Karnataka 571234

On June 11th June 2022, students of 1st and 2nd year BBA LLB(Hons), JSS Law College, Mysuru visited the SLN Coffee Pvt. Ltd., Kushalnagar, as a part of practical activity of the academic curriculum. The visit was organised by the faculties of college Smt. Tejaswini M and Mr. Pranav Nair and they accompanied the students for the visit.

The Harangi Reservoir and Hydro-electric Project, Kushalnagar:

EDCL owns and operates a run-of-the-river 9 MW (2X4.5 MW) Hydroelectric Power Project at Harangi River. The 9 MW Project was set up by the company in 1999 on the left bank of Harangi Dam (parallel to left bank irrigation canal), District Kodagu in Karnataka State. This visit let the students understand the mechanisms involved in a power generating process and the same was successfully achieved.
