Report of the Committee for Institutional Assessment and Audit of JSS Law College (Autonomous) constituted for the year 2022-23

Based on the pro-forma presentation made by the principal, interaction with students and faculty, visit to the facilities of the college, following observations are drawn by the Committee for future guidance of the college.

The Committee has gone through the information submitted to the Institutional Assessment and Audit Committee-2022-23 of JSS Law College which is an autonomous college affiliated to Karnataka State Law University, Hubballi. This college was established in 1982 with the approval of Government of Karnataka by JSS Mahavidyapeetha, Mysore. Since 1982 this college has been imparting legal education. It is running 3 years and 5 years LLB programs. The college obtained permanent affiliation in 1995 by University of Mysore. All the courses are recognized by Bar Council of India and got NAAC accreditation with A grade. The college has very good vision and mission to meet the needs of students and parents as well. This college was declared to fit under section 2(f) and 12 B of UGC Act 1956. The college has been focusing on interdisciplinary and multi-disciplinary approaches. In fact, it has got very good infrastructure having 2.5 acres, it means 5963 sq mts. of built area. The library is equipped with very good data depository having 13496 books, 25 journals, 284 CD's, 7 data bases, 1437 E-journals and 175 Dissertations. When we visited JSS hostels for men and women, observed that they are in good condition. Both hostels have accommodated 200 students. In addition, the college has administrative room, common room, canteen, well equipped auditorium, computer lab, medical and transport facilities. The committee visited indoor and outdoor sport facilities and it has got multi Gym for boys and girls separately. The courses offered are BA LLB (Hons.), BBA LLB (Hons.), LLB (3 years) and LLM. The intake for 5 years LLB courses is 60 seats as per Bar Council of India's rules. The college has got good faculty strength as regular, adhoc, contractual, guest faculty and visiting faculty. When interacted with all of the above, they shared their observations in relation to college and suggested to improve the quality of education based on research and development. The total sanctioned post are 13 aided, 10 non aided and 15 others

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and at present 37 faculty is working. As per the data available there are two Ph.D. holders, 4 M.Phil holders and 12 NET/SLET qualified teachers.

All the faculty members are highly active in participating and organizing workshops, seminars, conferences, symposia and moot court competitions. The Committee has assessed the teaching, learning and practical methods adopted by the college as per the rules of legal education. Since the college is autonomous, it has got its own examination and evaluation process with transparency. The admission policy and process is based on BCI rules and UGC guidelines. The entire examination is monitored by board of examination.


The achievements of students and teachers are indicated appropriately and the activities of the college are mentioned by Governing Body, Academic, Finance Committee and Board of Studies. In fact, all the information in connection to college are available in the website for general public.

Suggestions/Recommendations

1. Students feedback mechanism adopted by the college is good but the evaluation of the same is better to be got done by an external person with statistical knowledge background.
2. System adopted by the college for taking freshers to RIMSE and observe the activities of the institution full day is very useful practice.
3. As an autonomous college with PG programme the research output by the faculty is highly inadequate. There is lot of scope for the faculty to submit meaningful research proposals for funding to ICSSR, UGC and other agencies.
4. It is essential for the faculty with no Ph.D. get their doctoral degree as early as possible.
5. As desired by the students ladies washroom conditions in the college need to be improved urgently.
6. Law college students to be provide an opportunity to make use of the sports field of the JSS sister institutions by scheduling the timings to use the facilities.
7. It is better to adopt a common uniform for all the students of the college.




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8. Effective practices of NCC, NSS, Green practices, Swach Bharath, weekly assembly programmes and waste management should be considered seriously.
